








ARCHERY RANGE SAFETY

<p>ONLY draw a bow ON the line and IN THE DIRECTION OF THE TARGET</p> <p>Only put an arrow on the string when you are on the line and allowed to shoot.</p>	

	<p>Signals</p>
	<p>1 whistle: to shoot 2 whistles: Collect arrows 3 whistles: End of competition/shooting Verbal commands can replace whistle control</p>
	<p>The Emergency signal: STOP SHOOTING IMMEDIATELY</p>
<p>If you see someone in danger, shout "FAST" to stop all shooting</p>
